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There is a dusty dirt track extending 1500 miles down the spine of the Baja Peninsula in Mexico that leads to the Catavienia Desert - one of the most desolate and secret places on earth. A half days drive on a dirt road will, never seeing another soul, will bring the traveler to the Valley of the Cerios where only here on earth grows species Idria Columnaris - the Cirio. Also called the Boojum, a nick name coined by Lewis Carol.

Boojum grows less than an inch over several years and lives many millinimums in it's solitary habitat while time and the desert falls around it.

I have traveled these solitary roads and photographed portraits of these graceful creatures year upon year. I have chosen them as an iconic symbol of the passage of time and the treasure of their singular nature.

By selectively cracking the binary code and manipulating the data system of each of these photographs I have endeavored to invent a visual interpretation of these ancient trees standing as lone witnesses to the desert world as time and energy flows around them.

Hay una pista de tierra polvorienta que se extiende 1500 millas por la columna vertebral de la península de Baja en México y que conduce al desierto de Catavenia, uno de los lugares más desolados y secretos de la tierra. Un viaje de medio día por un camino de tierra, sin encontrar otra alma, llevará al viajero al Valle de los Cerios, único lugar donde crece la especie Idria Columnaris - el Cirio. También llamado Boojum, un apodo acuñado por Lewis Carol.

Boojum crece menos de una pulgada durante varios años y vive en su hábitat solitario mientras el tiempo y el desierto caen a su alrededor.

He viajado por estos caminos solitarios y he fotografiado estas elegantes criaturas año tras año, eligiéndolas como símbolo icónico del paso del tiempo y el tesoro de su singularidad. Al descifrar el código binario y manipular el sistema de datos de cada una de estas fotografías, me he esforzado por inventar una interpretación visual de estos árboles antiguos que se erigen como testigos solitarios del mundo desértico a medida que el tiempo y la energía fluyen a su alrededor.
